- Industrial legacy and Covid-19 have resulted in redundant sites and properties
- Over 26,000 hectares of brownfield sites identified across England in brownfield registers (CPRE, 2021) in
- Enough brownfield land for 1,162,969 housing units over 21,500 sites (CPRE, 2020)
- Opportunity to develop greener and more energy efficient brownfield sites

The workshop will:

- Explore brownfield as a future investment and expansion opportunity
- Debate current challenges associated with brownfield regeneration- from business perspective
- Discuss government strategy, funding, land remediation relief and business support available
- Demonstrate a successful brownfield regeneration case study and a tour








